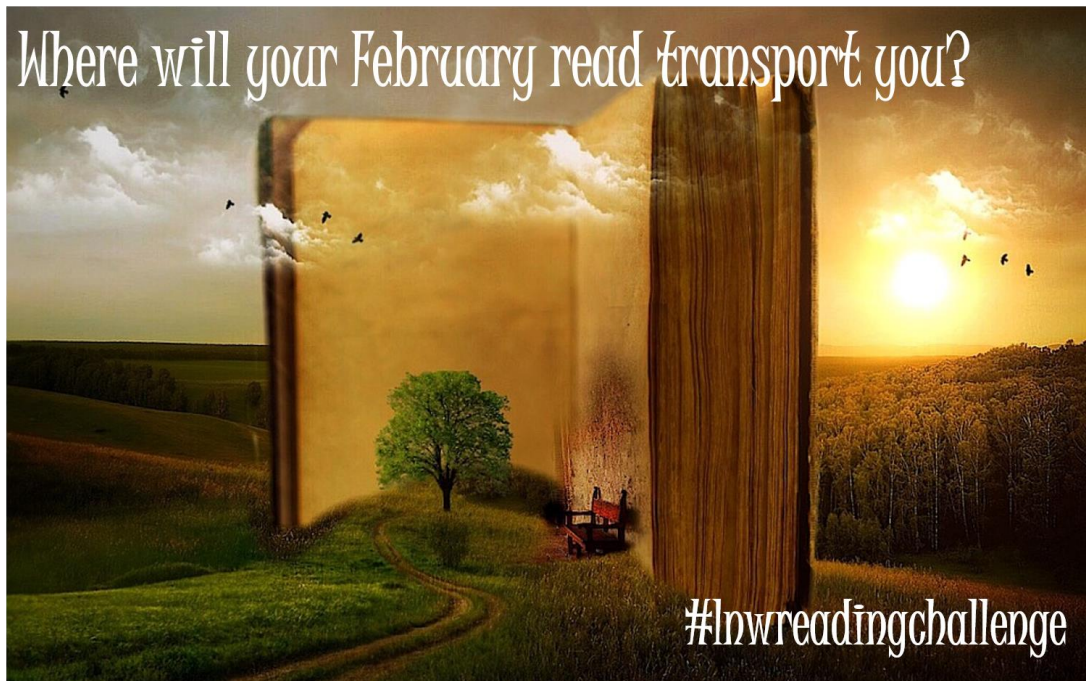


# Reading Challenge: February

**November:** Read a novel based on a true story

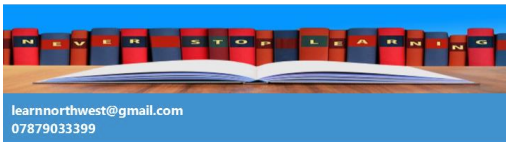
**December:** Read the first story in a trilogy or series
